As a non-profit organization, we work in many ways to reduce the high cost of bleeding disorder care. **Our factor prices are lower than commercial pharmacy prices, and all infusion-related supplies are included.**

All of our revenues above operating expenses are returned to the community. This supports the Comprehensive Hemophilia Treatment Centers (HTCs) and other consumer programs, services and events as determined by our volunteer board of directors. Most board members are from the hemophilia community and all understand its needs.

Community Partnership

Cascade was created as a community partnership, and the concept of partnering is central to our service. We are reliable, confidential, and convenient.

We help meet your medical needs by partnering with your treatment team to provide information to you about the latest products, treatment options, and community news.

We also work with your Treatment Center and your insurance company to ensure any necessary authorizations and documentation are efficiently submitted.

Consumer-Focused Care

As part of the Hemophilia Treatment Center network, Cascade has established relationships with your HTC staff, and we are able to respond quickly to any special requests or prescribed changes in medications. Because we believe in the importance of informed consumers, we supply educational materials and maintain a comprehensive recall notification policy to keep you up-to-date on important developments in treatment and product safety.

We stay in touch with you in other ways as well. Our clinical care team can answer any medication questions you may have, help resolve any problems with your coverage, or provide psychosocial support, insurance education, and financial resources to assist you.
